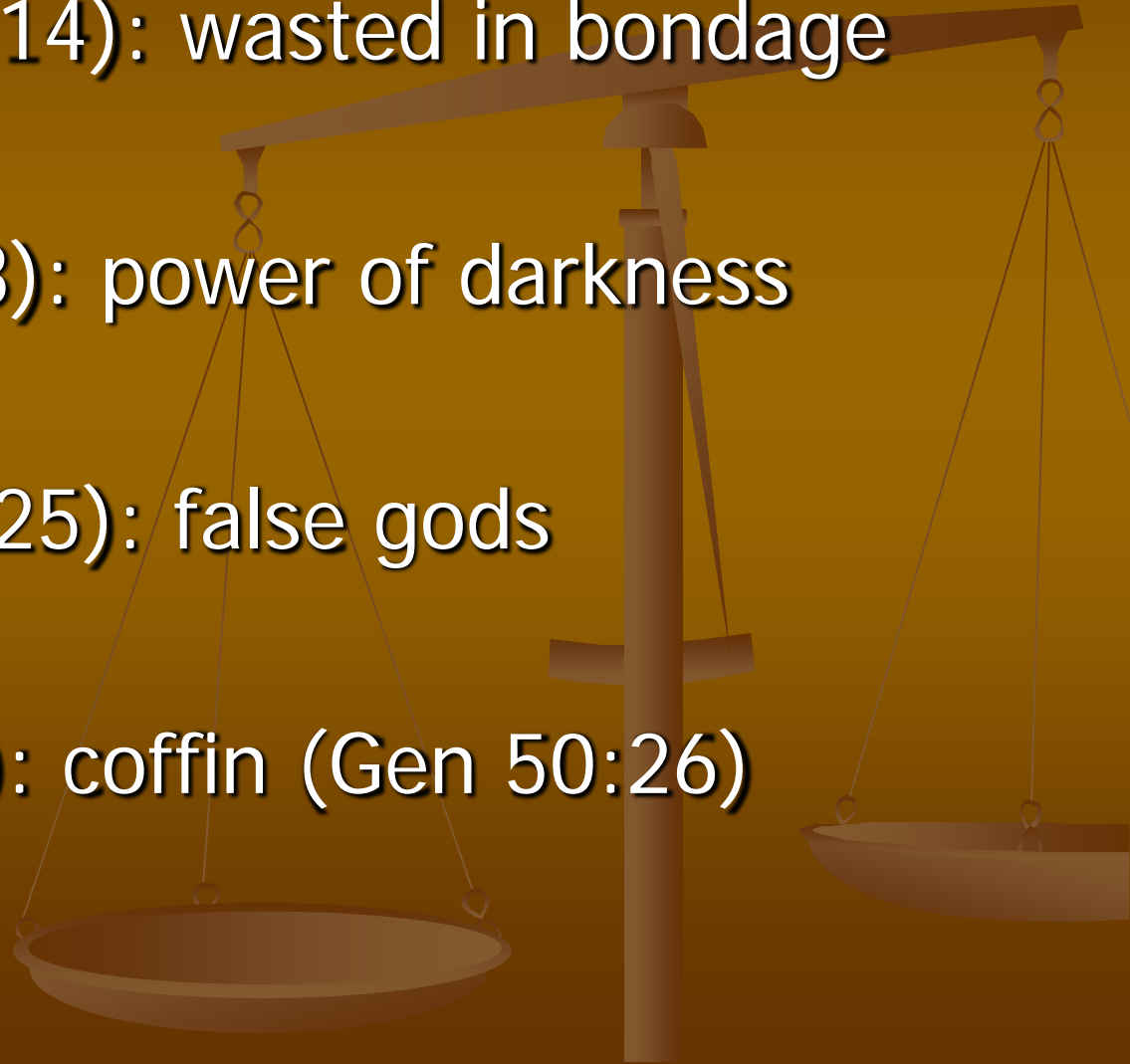

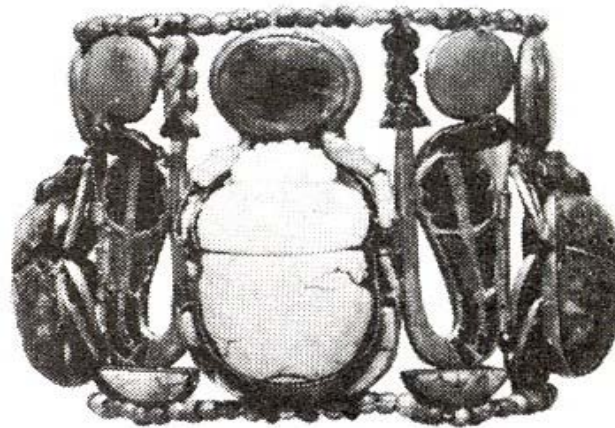
The Life of Moses

- Death (Ex 1:16): coffin (Gen 50:26)

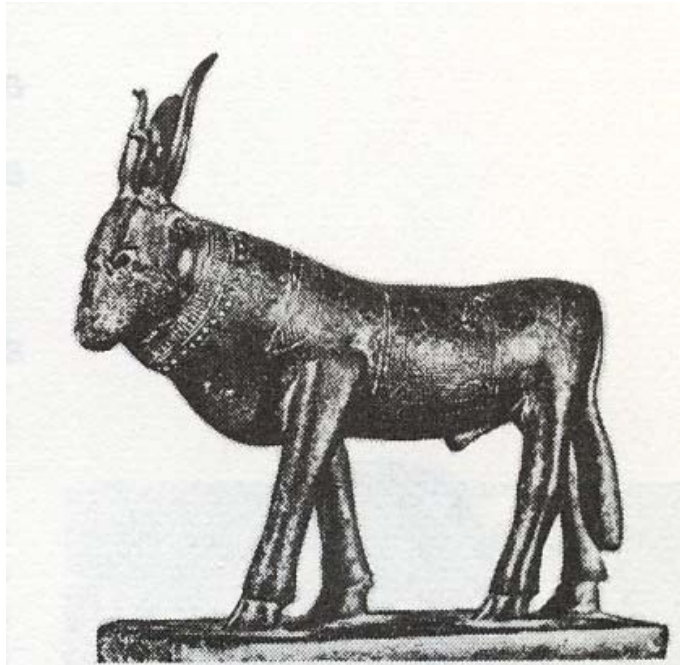




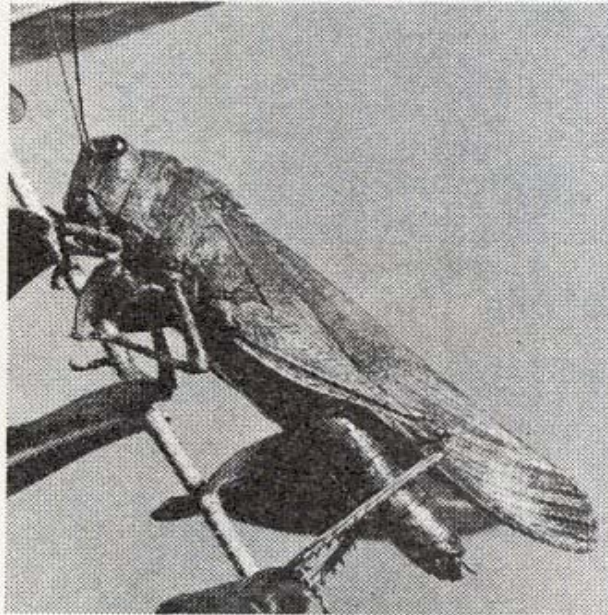

Tutankhamen*

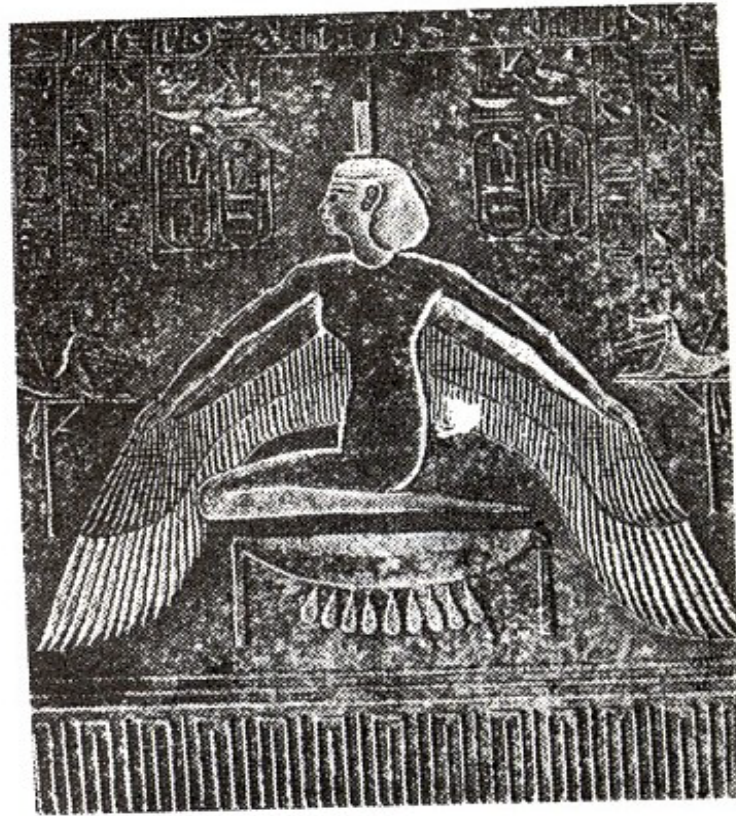

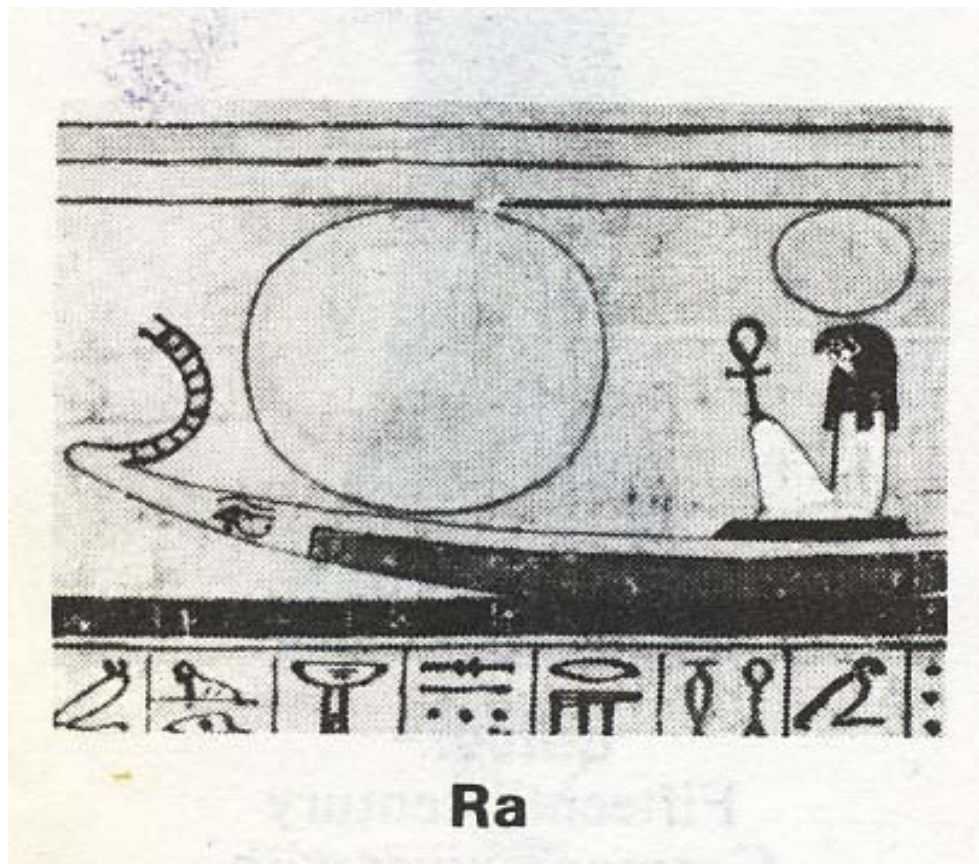

John 5:24

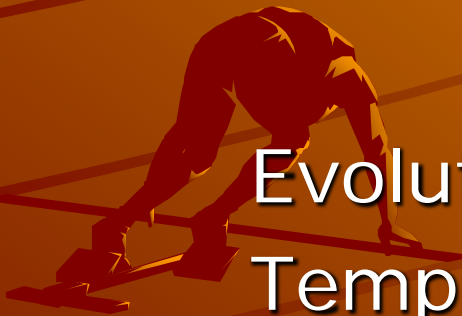

Moses: The Man of the Hour

- ◆ An Egyptian: His importance
(Exo 2:19)
- ◆ A man of God: His impotence
(Deut 33:1)
- ◆ Servant of the Lord: God's omnipotence
(Deut 34:5)
- ◆ Prophet (Deut 34:10): Face to face



Moses: The Man of the Hour

◆ Hebrews 11:24-28

- ◆ Refused: prince >>>> Christ
- ◆ Chose not sin >>>> Reward
- ◆ Forsake king >>>> The invisible

◆ He kept the Passover for the people

The Call of Moses

- The burning bush (Exo 3:1-5)
- Mt. Horeb Mt. Sinai
- "Moses, Moses"

- God's presence
- God's mercy
- God's power
- God's revelation

The Call of Moses

- "Who am I?" (Exo 3:11): No fitness
- Answer: I will be with you.
You will bring people out.
They will serve Me.

The Call of Moses

■ "Who are you?" (Exo 3:13): No message

■ Answer: To the Israelites (3:14)

"I AM"

God of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob
Jehovah

To the elders (3:16), To the Pharaoh(3:18)

The Call of Moses

- "What evidence?" (Exo 4:1): No authority
- Answer:
 - The serpent (4:2-5)
 - The leprosy (4:6-7)
 - The blood (4:9)

The Call of Moses

- "What speech?" (Exo 4:10): No gift
- Answer: God made mouth (4:11)
 - God gave gift of speech (4:12)
 - God gave messages (4:15b)

Bottom line: Moses had no inclination (4:13)

The Call of Moses

- The promises of God to the man of God:
All began at the mountain of God
 - God's presence
 - God's plan
 - God's name(s)
 - God's power
 - God's gift of speech
 - God's message
 - God's rod

- First altar(17:15): Jehovah nissi

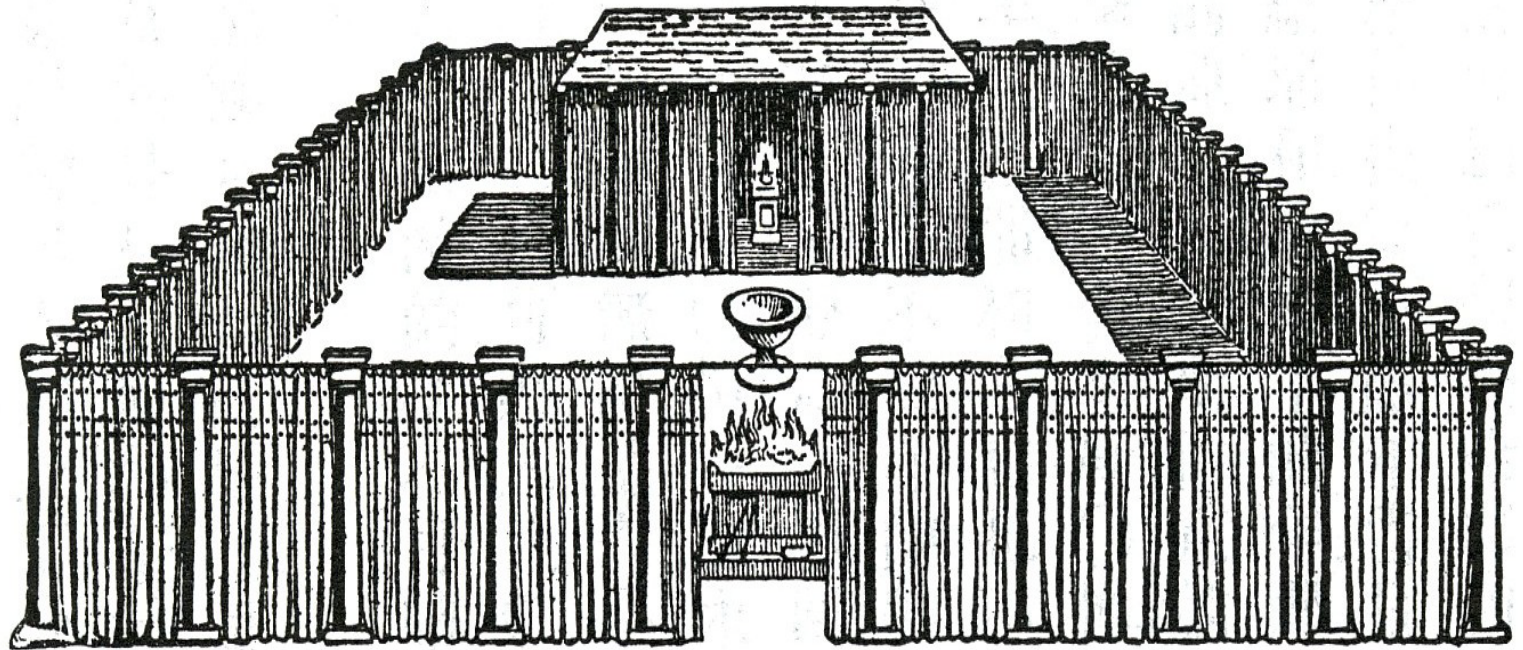

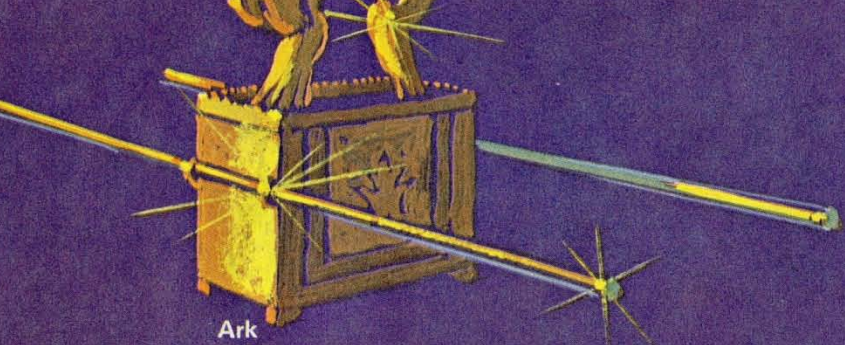
- Jehovah jireh (Gen. 22:14): Provision

Moses and the Tabernacle

- Beyond the fence >>> The 12 tribes
- The outer court >>> The Levites
- The Holy place >>> The priests
- Holy of Holies >>> The High Priest



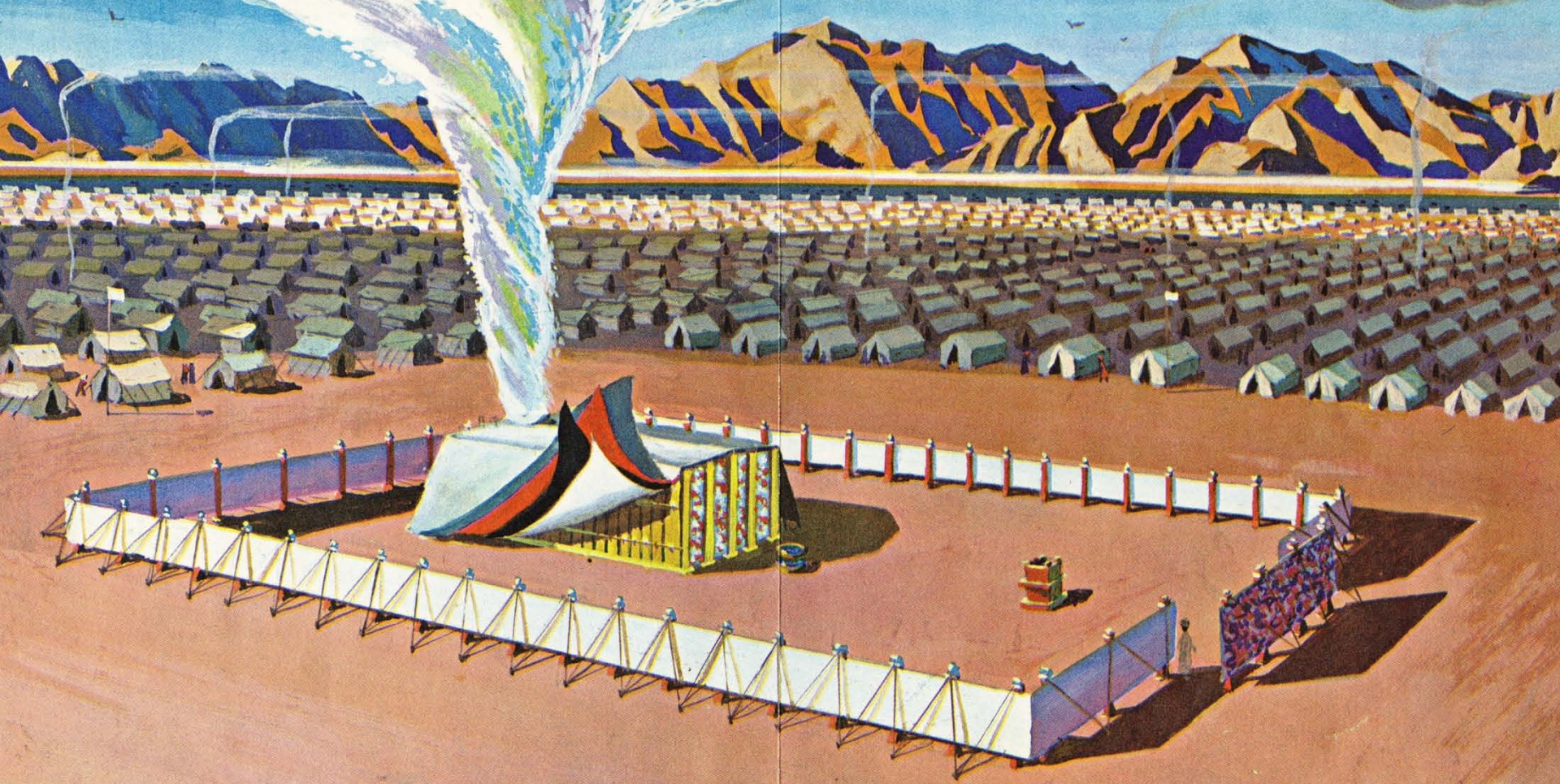
Moses and the Tabernacle

- The 12 tribes:
 - unbelief, unwilling, unable, unrest
 - "Do not come near"
- The Levites:
 - Sided with Moses
 - Redeemed by Aaron
 - Numbered by God
 - Serving in grace
 - Korah's rebellion

Moses and the Tabernacle

- The priests:
 - The anointing
 - Ministry as a reward
 - Given the Levites as a gift
 - The lamp, the bread, the incense
- The High Priest: Day of atonement
 - By Him, through Him, in Him





In the Tabernacle

Gold represents deity

Silver represents redemption

Brass represents judgment

Blue represents heaven

Purple represents royalty

Scarlet represents sacrifice

Fine linen represents righteousness

Goats' hair represents atonement

Rams' skins represent atonement

Badgers' skins represent humanity
(outward appearance) of Christ

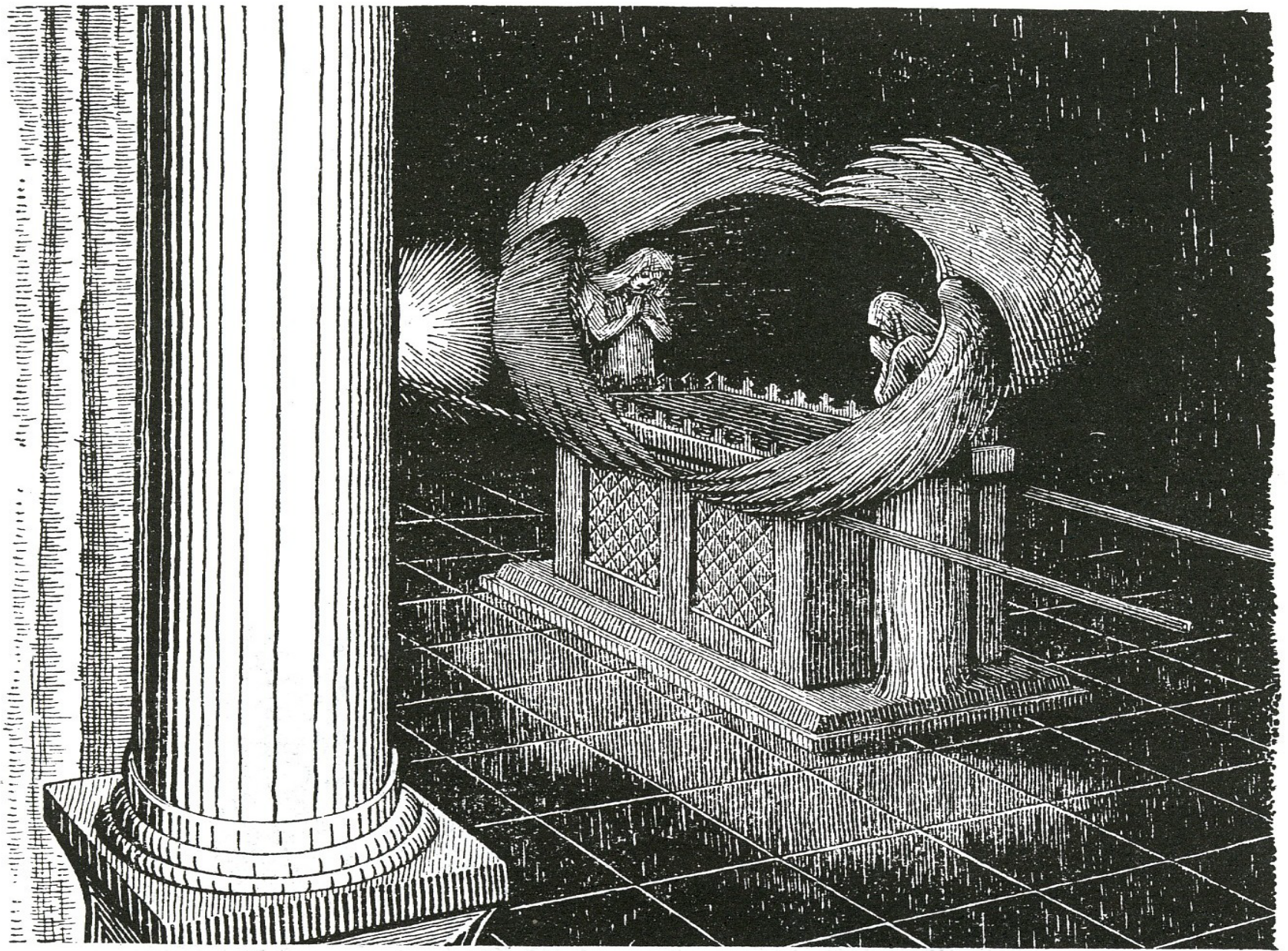
Wood (acacia) represents humanity of Christ

Oil represents the Holy Spirit

- Three partitions to the Holy of Holies:
- Main-gate >>> The way
Romans 1:16
- Holy Place >>> The truth
Isa 9:6
- The veil >>> The life
I Cor 1:30
